

# Sausage Roll Pillowcase Fun!

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## Supplies:

### For regular sized pillow:

$\frac{3}{4}$  yard of main fabric  
 $\frac{1}{4}$  yard for cuff  
 $\frac{1}{8}$  yard for accent

### For travel pillow:

$\frac{1}{2}$  yard main fabric  
 $\frac{1}{4}$  yard cuff  
 $\frac{1}{8}$  yard accent

## Directions: (Directions for travel pillow in parentheses)

### 1. Cutting:

1. cut your main fabric: 27" x 42" (17" x 25")
2. cut your cuff fabric: 9" x 42" (8" x 25")
3. cut your accent fabric: 3" x 42" (3" x 25")

2. Press the accent fabric wrong sides together to create a  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" ( $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 25") piece.
3. Pin the accent to the main fabric, matching raw edges.

\*Prairie points: create prairie points and pin/baste to the accent fabric. Keep the prairie points on one half of the accent.

4. Pin the long sides of the cuff fabric to the main fabric, right sides together. Sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam.
5. Roll the long layer of the main pillow fabric until you have all the fabric in a long tube at the top of the attached fabrics. Bring unsewn edge of cuff over the long tube of fabric to the sewn edge, matching raw edges, pin. Sew together in a slightly larger  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam.
6. Turn right side out! Yes it will come thru!
7. Lay flat & press.
8. Fold pillowcase with **WRONG** sides together. Even up edges if needed. Pin & sew with a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam.
9. Turn the pillowcase *wrong side out*, press. Sew together using a slightly larger  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. Turn & enjoy!
